ABOUT THE SCHOLARSHIP

The Ashley Chen scholarship is an annual award designed to keep alive, enshrine, and acknowledge the values Ashley consistently demonstrated. It is dedicated to a graduating girl who combines a high level of skill and on-field competitiveness. The recipient will demonstrate similar strength of character in addition to a positive attitude toward the game, coaches, officials, team-mates, and opponents.

Like Ashley, this hardworking athlete will also have combined her on-field dedication with fairness, compassion for others, humility, and good-naturedness off the field.

The scholarship will be awarded to a student proceeding from Grade 12 to any post-secondary institution. The scholarship is conditional in that funds will be dispersed at such time as the recipient provides proof that she is attending the post-secondary institution. In order to be eligible to receive this scholarship, the player must have been registered with the Richmond District this past season (2017-2018) and be a Richmond resident.
